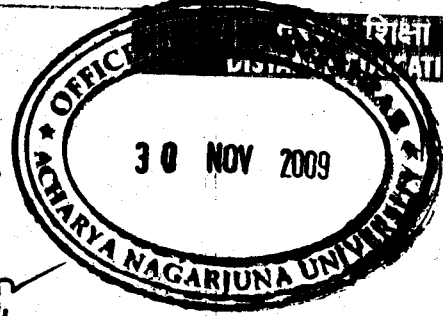

Dear Sir,

This has reference to your application requesting for Ex-Post-Facto recognition of Distance Education Council for programmes offered through distance mode by the Acharya Nagarjuna University, Guntur, Andhra Pradesh.

In this connection, we would like to inform you that based on the recommendations of the Standing Committee of DEC that evaluated the application of your university, the Distance Education Council has accorded Ex-Post-Facto approval to your university for programmes offered through distance mode with effect from 1995 to academic year 2007-08 as per the enclosed list in Annexure-I. Prior to March 1995, there was no system for giving recognition to correspondence courses or distance education programmes and therefore the issue of Ex-Post-Facto approval for such courses during that period does not arise. The certificates issued by the university stand automatically recognized if they were approved by the relevant authorities of the university. It may be noted that any degree/diploma/certificate offered through a franchising agency by the university does not have the approval of Distance Education Council.

Further, we would also like to inform that, it is the responsibility of the university to follow the norms prescribed by the concerned regulatory bodies or seek their approval for professional/technical programme/s as per the requirements. Getting approval of concerned statutory apex body for relevant programme/s will be the sole responsibility of the university. The territorial jurisdiction for offering distance education would be as per the Acts and Statutes of your university during the period of Ex-Post-Facto approval.

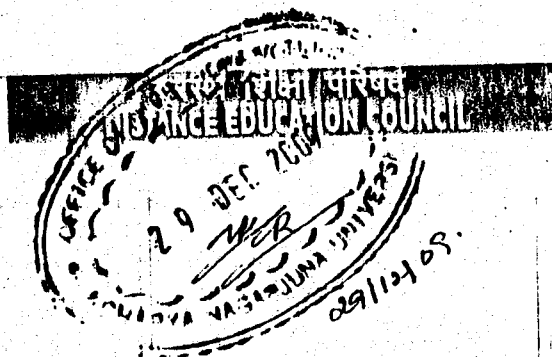



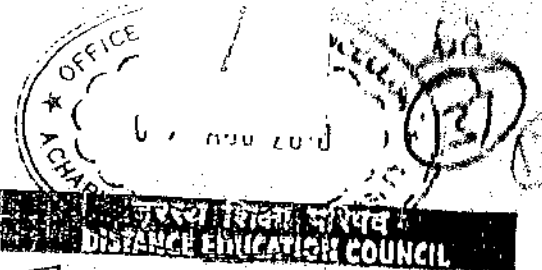

*The programmes are professional in nature, they require approval from the concerned Statutory Councils. Technical, Engineering programmes require AICTE recognition. Any other professional degree requires approval from the concerned Statutory Councils. It will be the responsibility of your institution to seek prior approval from the concerned statutory Councils/regulatory bodies, wherever required.

A. The recognition to above programme is subject to the compliance of the following by the Institution. (131)

- (i) The university should appoint more faculty so as to have at least one faculty per programme to support the distance education programme as per DEC norms.
- (ii) Some of the printed material, particularly for technical/professional programmes need revision and updation. Curriculum for various programme particularly of professional programmes should be industry and need based.
- (iii) The university should follow the self learning methodology in updating, preparation of the new course ware and will improve its existing course ware by involving more experts on their advisory committees representing industries and academicians for preparing syllabus and developing, updating and revising the course materials as per ODL pedagogy.
- (iv) As far as nomenclature of various programmes on offer is concerned, the university should follow the UGC guidelines.
- (v) The university should provide extensive training to the faculty, coordinators and academic counselors with the help of STRIDE, IGNOU to improve the existing study material.
- (vi) The university should make use of ICT in the context of distance education system for the effective delivery of programmes. Audio/visual, multimedia materials need to be developed. University should use EDUSAT also for which the university can approach those Institutions which are already making use of EDUSAT or IGNOU.

B. The University/Institution may note that:

1. The Institution will offer only such programmes through distance mode which are offered by the Institution through regular face-to-face mode and approved by the Distance Education Council as mentioned in this letter. The Institution will not offer any other programme through distance mode other than those approved by the Distance Education Council.
2. Technical, Engineering programmes require AICTE recognition. Any other professional programme requires approval from the concerned Statutory Council.
3. Programmes in the areas of Health, Nursing, Dentistry, and allied areas may be offered with the approval of the statutory councils/regulatory bodies, wherever required.
4. It will be the responsibility of the Institution to follow the norms prescribed by the regulatory bodies, and seek their approval, wherever required.
5. The nomenclature of the programmes should be strictly as prescribed by the UGC/AICTE and approved by the Distance Education Council.
6. The eligibility conditions and duration of programmes will be as per the DEC norms and for professional and technical programmes as per the norms laid down by the AICTE. No admission to MBA, PGDBM and MCA programmes can be done without ensuring that the student has secured a valid score in the entrance test examination for this purpose.
7. The Institution shall limit admission to maximum 60 seats per programme per Study Centre for Management, Computer & IT, and Allied Health Sciences programmes. For laboratory/Practical work, the Institution can have a maximum of 30 students in a batch subject to maximum 60 students per Study Centre. The Study Centre be owned by the University and should be opened with the approval of EC/BOM of the University concerned.
8. The Institution should have at least one full time faculty member exclusively for coordinating each programme.
9. The territorial jurisdiction for offering programmes through distance mode will be as per the decision taken in the 35th Meeting of the Distance Education


Council. In its 35th meeting the Council noted that distance education and online education cannot have the Territorial Jurisdiction. In case of Central Universities and the State Universities, the Territorial Jurisdiction will be as per their Acts and Statutes for offering programmes through distance mode. The Territorial Jurisdiction in case of Deemed Universities will be as per UGC, which mandates the prior approval of the UGC for opening Centres / off Campus Centres outside the Headquarters. The Territorial Jurisdiction in case of Private Institutions (other than Universities) will be as decided by the Joint Committee, which has decided that the territorial jurisdiction for the institutions (both private as well as Govt funded) shall be the Headquarters, and in no case outside the State.

10. The Distance Education Council prohibits franchising of Study Centres. Thus, your Institution will not franchise any Study Centre.
11. The Institution's management of the distance education programmes will be open for review and inspection from time to time by DEC to provide inputs for further improvement or as deemed necessary. The academic norms of the programmes shall be under monitoring and regulation by the concerned regulatory authorities.
12. For Management and Computer Science programmes, the Institution should also note that
 - The programme should have a mandatory internship of six months;
 - Institute/University concerned should seek accreditation from National Board of Accreditation as per prevailing rules;
 - Institute/University concerned should have concerned Department and the conventional universities should have on campus programme on offer;
 - Institute/University concerned should not have advertised for the programmes before receiving the approval letter;
 - Institute/University concerned should disclose, on line, in public domain the details of the student admitted, centre-wise, as per the format to be prescribed by AICTE;
 - Institute/University concerned should ensure delivery of the course material on-line with in one year of the date of approval;

It may be noted that before launching the programme the Institution should submit an affidavit within 30 days from date of issue of this letter that it agrees to and will abide by all terms and conditions contained in this letter. In case, the DEC does not receive the affidavit within 30 days from date of issue of this letter, the approval accorded to your Institution will be considered as withdrawn. Further, if it is found that the Institution is flouting any norms, then the recognition accorded to your Institution will be withdrawn without any notice.



Accordingly, the recognition accorded to your University, vide the above said letter of UGC, is hereby continued for the academic year 2015-16. Your University may therefore continue to offer the programmes in ODL mode, approval for which was accorded vide DEC letter no. DEC/RECOG/2010/2304 dated 04.08.2010. (copy attached).

2 The university shall scrupulously abide by the following terms and conditions, while offering the programmes through distance learning mode during the session 2015-16 in accordance with the Affidavit dated 18.06.2015, duly notarised and signed by Sri P. Raja Sekhar, Registrar of the university, submitted to the commission vide letter dated 08.07.2015 :-

- i) The University shall offer only those programmes through Open and Distance Learning (ODL) mode, which are approved by the statutory bodies of the University as per norms and also by UGC and wherever necessary by the apex regulatory bodies in the country.
- ii) It is the responsibility of the University to follow the norms prescribed by the concerned regulatory body/ies such as UGC, AICTE, NCTE/any other and also seek its/their prior approval, wherever required.

- iii) The University shall not start any new programme without prior approval of UGC and other concerned regulatory authorities in anticipation of recognition.

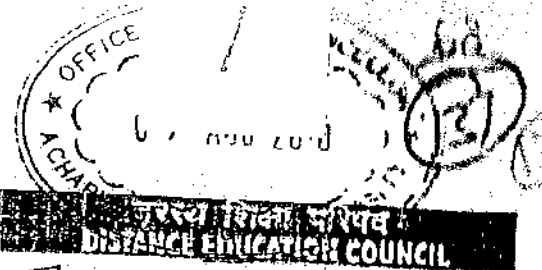

*The programmes are professional in nature, they require approval from the concerned Statutory Councils. Technical, Engineering programmes require AICTE recognition. Any other professional degree requires approval from the concerned Statutory Councils. Hence, the approval accorded by the DEC is conditional subject to the approval of the AICTE and any other Statutory Councils. It will be the responsibility of your institution to seek prior approval from the concerned statutory Councils/regulatory bodies, wherever required.

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A. The recognition to above programme is subject to the compliance of the following by the Institution. (131)

- (i) The university should appoint more faculty so as to have at least one faculty per programme to support the distance education programme as per DEC norms.
- (ii) Some of the printed material, particularly for technical/professional programmes need revision and updation. Curriculum for various programme particularly of professional programmes should be industry and need based.
- (iii) The university should follow the self learning methodology in updating, preparation of the new course ware and will improve its existing course ware by involving more experts on their advisory committees representing industries and academicians for preparing syllabus and developing, updating and revising the course materials as per ODL pedagogy.
- (iv) As far as nomenclature of various programmes on offer is concerned, the university should follow the UGC guidelines.
- (v) The university should provide extensive training to the faculty, coordinators and academic counselors with the help of STRIDE, IGNOU to improve the existing study material.
- (vi) The university should make use of ICT in the context of distance education system for the effective delivery of programmes. Audio/visual, multimedia materials need to be developed. University should use EDUSAT also for which the university can approach those Institutions which are already making use of EDUSAT or IGNOU.

B. The University/Institution may note that:

1. The Institution will offer only such programmes through distance mode which are offered by the Institution through regular face-to-face mode and approved by the Distance Education Council as mentioned in this letter. The Institution will not offer any other programme through distance mode other than those approved by the Distance Education Council.
2. Technical, Engineering programmes require AICTE recognition. Any other professional programme requires approval from the concerned Statutory Council.
3. Programmes in the areas of Health, Nursing, Dentistry, and allied areas may be offered with the approval of the statutory councils/regulatory bodies, wherever required.
4. It will be the responsibility of the Institution to follow the norms prescribed by the regulatory bodies, and seek their approval, wherever required.
5. The nomenclature of the programmes should be strictly as prescribed by the UGC/AICTE and approved by the Distance Education Council.
6. The eligibility conditions and duration of programmes will be as per the DEC norms and for professional and technical programmes as per the norms laid down by the AICTE. No admission to MBA, PGDBM and MCA programmes can be done without ensuring that the student has secured a valid score in the entrance test examination for this purpose.
7. The Institution shall limit admission to maximum 60 seats per programme per Study Centre for Management, Computer & IT, and Allied Health Sciences programmes. For laboratory/Practical work, the Institution can have a maximum of 30 students in a batch subject to maximum 60 students per Study Centre. The Study Centre be owned by the University and should be opened with the approval of EC/BOM of the University concerned.
8. The Institution should have at least one full time faculty member exclusively for coordinating each programme.
9. The territorial jurisdiction for offering programmes through distance mode will be as per the decision taken in the 35th Meeting of the Distance Education



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
Council. In its 35th meeting the Council noted that distance education and online education cannot have the Territorial Jurisdiction. In case of Central Universities and the State Universities, the Territorial Jurisdiction will be as per their Acts and Statutes for offering programmes through distance mode. The Territorial Jurisdiction in case of Deemed Universities will be as per UGC, which mandates the prior approval of the UGC for opening Centres / off Campus Centres outside the Headquarters. The Territorial Jurisdiction in case of Private Institutions (other than Universities) will be as decided by the Joint Committee, which has decided that the territorial jurisdiction for the institutions (both private as well as Govt funded) shall be the Headquarters, and in no case outside the State.

10. The Distance Education Council prohibits franchising of Study Centres. Thus, your Institution will not franchise any Study Centre.
11. The Institution's management of the distance education programmes will be open for review and inspection from time to time by DEC to provide inputs for further improvement or as deemed necessary. The academic norms of the programmes shall be under monitoring and regulation by the concerned regulatory authorities.
12. For Management and Computer Science programmes, the Institution should also note that
 - The programme should have a mandatory internship of six months;
 - Institute/University concerned should seek accreditation from National Board of Accreditation as per prevailing rules;
 - Institute/University concerned should have concerned Department and the conventional universities should have on campus programme on offer;
 - Institute/University concerned should not have advertised for the programmes before receiving the approval letter;
 - Institute/University concerned should disclose, on line, in public domain the details of the student admitted, centre-wise, as per the format to be prescribed by AICTE;
 - Institute/University concerned should ensure delivery of the course material on-line with in one year of the date of approval;

It may be noted that before launching the programme the Institution should submit an affidavit within 30 days from date of issue of this letter that it agrees to and will abide by all terms and conditions contained in this letter. In case, the DEC does not receive the affidavit within 30 days from date of issue of this letter, the approval accorded to your Institution will be considered as withdrawn. Further, if it is found that the Institution is flouting any norms, then the recognition accorded to your Institution will be withdrawn without any notice.



Sir/Madam,

This is in reference to your proposal submitted for consideration of recognition in response to UGC letter F.No. 12-3/2016 (DEB-III) dated 21.03.2016 and subsequent interface meeting attended by your University/Institutions. In this regard, I am directed to inform that it has been decided to accord recognition to your institution to offer certain programmes through distance mode for two academic years i.e. 2016-17 and 2017-18 subject to strict adherence and compliance of the conditions mentioned in this letter.

2 The university shall scrupulously abide by the following terms and conditions, while offering the programmes through distance learning mode in accordance with the Affidavit dated 7th April, 2016, duly notarised and signed by Prof. K. John Paul, Registrar of the University, submitted to the Commission.

3 The recognition accorded to the institution will be valid only for the programmes/courses as mentioned in the list attached with this letter.

- i) The University shall offer only those programmes through Open and Distance Learning (ODL) mode, which are approved by the statutory bodies of the University as per norms and also by UGC and wherever necessary by the apex regulatory bodies in the country.
- ii) It is the responsibility of the University to follow the norms prescribed by the concerned regulatory body/ies such as UGC, AICTE, NCTE/any other and also seek its/their prior approval, wherever required.
- iii) The University shall not start any new programme without prior approval of UGC and other concerned regulatory authorities in anticipation of recognition.
- iv) The nomenclature of all the programmes to be offered under distance mode shall be strictly as per UGC/AICTE Regulations.

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v) No teacher education programme shall be offered without prior approval of the NCTE (as per new NCTE regulations,2014)

vi) The Ministry of HRD's directions prohibiting B.E/ B.Tech through distance mode vide it's letter dated 29.07.2009 shall be adhered to strictly.

vii) The programmes in Engineering and Technology e.g. B.E/ B.Tech/ Diploma and courses in Medicines/ Nursing/ Physiotherapy etc. are not allowed and the University will not be offering the same.

viii) The university shall refrain from offering such programmes that are not allowed to be offered, through distance mode by the respective apex body/ies.

ix) No online programme leading to award of Degree/ Certification shall be offered by the University, until a policy is framed and approved by UGC in this regard.

x) The minimum duration of a programme, offered in ODL mode shall not be less than the minimum duration of similar programme offered through the regular mode. Nomenclature of programme and the minimum eligibility criteria for admission should be as per UGC norms and Regulations.

xi) The University shall run its ODL programmes only in those subjects/ fields which are offered by it through regular mode.

xii) The university shall have at least one full time faculty member exclusively for coordinating each programme at the headquarters

xiii) The eligibility conditions for admissions to each course to be offered through distance learning mode shall be as per norms of UGC/AICTE and other regulatory bodies.

xiv) The territorial jurisdiction in respect of University for offering programmes through distance mode will be as per the policy of UGC on territorial jurisdiction and opening of off campuses/centres/study centres as mentioned in the UGC notification No.F.27-1/2012(CPP-II), dated 27th June 2013, a copy of which is also posted on the UGC website www.ugc.ac.in/deb.

xv) The programmes in distance mode will not be offered through franchising arrangement and /or through any private institution /college

xvi) The Institution will have necessary infrastructure at its HQ as well as its Study Centres (if any) for conduction of practical work, wherever required.

4. Moreover, the University shall not offer any M.Phil/Ph.D Programme through distance learning mode in compliance to clause 5 of the UGC (Minimum Standard and Procedure for awards of M.Phil./Ph.D Degree), Regulation 2009.

5. The Institution's management of the distance education programmes will be open for review and inspection by the UGC. The academic norms of the programmes shall be under monitoring by the concerned regulatory authorities.


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6. It may also be noted that:

- i. If the institution fails to comply with the conditions of recognition for which the Affidavit, as mentioned above has been submitted or if it is found conducting affairs in a manner that leads to deterioration of academic standards, the UGC may withdraw its recognition at any stage. The University will be solely responsible for the same.
- ii. The recognition can be reviewed depending on change of policy with reference to ODL Regulations or otherwise.
- iii. In case any information, documentary evidence submitted/produced by the University/institution is found to be false or fake at a later stage, the recognition of University/institution shall be withdrawn and the University/Institution concerned shall be solely responsible for the all consequences arising out of the same.


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

Sir/Madam,

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 26 read with clause (j) of Section 12 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 (3 of 1956), the University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning) Regulations, 2017, had been notified in the Gazette of India on 23.06.2017. The first and the second amendment in the principal regulations were notified in the Gazette of India on 11.10.2017 and 06.02.2018 respectively.

2. Part-II; sub-regulations (3) to (5); of the University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning) Regulations, 2017 describes the Recognition process of Higher Educational Institutions for offering Open and Distance Learning programmes. The sub-regulations (3) describes the process of recognition of Higher Educational Institutions offering programmes in Open and Distance Learning Mode, whereas sub-regulations (4) describes the process for withdrawal of recognition and sub-regulations (5) provides right to appeal to Higher Educational Institutions aggrieved with the decision of the Commission.

3. The Commission had invited online applications from the eligible Higher Educational Institutions for offering Open and Distance Learning programmes from the academic session 2018-19 vide public notice F.No. 74-1/2018 (DEB-IV) dated 28.03.2018, mentioning therein that the online portal for submitting applications shall-be open from 2ndApril, 2018 to 1stMay, 2018. It was also mentioned that the duly certified hard copies of the application submitted online mode along with annexures shall reach UGC (DEB) office at 35 Feroze Shah Road, New Delhi-110001 within 10 working days of submission of online application. In response to the public notice dated 28.03.2018, **Acharya Nagarjuna University, Andhra Pradesh** had submitted application online for programme wise recognition by the Commission.

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4. Application received from **Aacharya Nagarjuna University, Andhra Pradesh** had been scrutinized by the Expert Committee and deficiency(s) or defect(s) in application were communicated and time period as prescribed in University Grants Commission (Open & Distance Learning) Regulations, 2017 was given to remove or rectify such deficiency(s) or defect(s) with relevant documentary evidence.

5. The **Aacharya Nagarjuna University, Andhra Pradesh** was invited for an Interface Meeting with the Expert Committee; constituted by the Chairman of the Commission; on **5th July, 2018** in the UGC office, Bahadurshah Zafar Marg, New Delhi. The Expert Committee based on the application submitted, clarification given for deficiency(s) or defect(s) communicated earlier, the presentation made by the Higher Educational Institution in the Interface Meeting and in terms of provisions of the University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning) Regulations, 2017 and its amendments; made recommendations for consideration of the Commission.

6. The Commission in its 534th meeting held on 2nd August, 2018 considered the recommendations of the Interface Expert Committee. Based on the decision of the Commission, I am directed to issue this Order, thereby communicating the programme wise recognition status of the programmes to be offered in Open and Distance Learning mode from academic year 2018-19 onwards by the **Aacharya Nagarjuna University, Andhra Pradesh**; as detailed in point no. 7 below.

10. If the HEI fails to comply with the conditions of recognition or if it is found conducting affairs in a manner that leads to deterioration of academic standards, if any information, documentary evidence submitted/produced by the HEI is found to be false or fake at a later date, UGC shall take action as per Regulation (4) Part-II of UGC (ODL) Regulations, 2017.

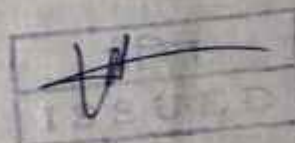

Sir/Madam,

This is in continuation to the UGC letter of even number dated 16.08.2018, wherein the details of programmes recognised for 2018-19 onwards and programmes found deficient along with deficiencies and other relevant information/conditions were communicated to **Acharya Nagarjuna University, Andhra Pradesh.**

2. As per the provision at clause 4 (i) of sub-regulation (3) of Part- II of the University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning) Regulations, 2017 and the decision of the Commission in its 534th meeting held on 2nd August, 2018, for the programmes found deficient as per the UGC letter cited in above para, the Higher Educational Institution had been provided an opportunity to submit representation along with documentary evidence, if any, within 30 days from the date of the said UGC letter.

3. The representation along with documentary evidence submitted by the **Acharya Nagarjuna University, Andhra Pradesh** on 06.09.2018 for review and the justifications given by the HEI representatives during the hearing, were considered by the duly constituted Expert Review Committee in the meeting held on 18.09.2018 at UGC, 35 Feroze Shah Road, New Delhi. The Expert Review Committee based on the provisions of the University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning) Regulations, 2017 and its amendments; made recommendations for consideration of the Commission.

4. Based on the decision of the Commission in its 535th Meeting dated 27th September, 2018, I am directed to issue this Order, thereby communicating the Commission decision, on the representation received, for programme wise recognition status of the programmes to be offered in Open and Distance Learning

mode from academic year 2018-19 onwards by the Acharya Nagarjuna University, Andhra Pradesh, in addition to programmes already recognized vide letter mentioned in Para 1 above, as detailed in point no. 5 below.

Some specific conditions as per UGC (ODL) Regulations, 2017 & its amendments are given in **Annexure-1**.

7. For the programmes not recognised in 5(B) above, the Higher Educational Institution may prefer an appeal to the Commission, if any, along with fee of Rupees ten thousand per programme in the form of demand draft drawn in favour of Secretary, UGC, within 30 days from the date of this order, as per the provision of sub-regulation (5) of Part- II of the University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning) Regulations, 2017 and decision of the Commission in its 534th Meeting dated 02.08.2018.

8. If the HEI fails to comply with the conditions of recognition or if it is found conducting affairs in a manner that leads to deterioration of academic standards, or if any information, documentary evidence submitted/produced by the HEI is found

to be false or fake at a later date, UGC shall take action as per Regulation (4) Part - II of UGC (ODL) Regulations, 2017.

2. For the programmes recognized in 8(i) above, the Higher Educational Institution shall comply with all the provisions of the University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020 while offering the programmes in Open and Distance Learning mode. 10. For the programmes not recognized in 8(ii) above, the Higher Educational Institution may prefer an appeal if any, along with documentary evidence to the Commission and shall also be uploaded on UGC-DEB portal, as per the provision stipulated under Regulations 6 of Part-II of


the University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020. The appeal shall be accompanied by a copy of the order appealed against along with a fee of Rupees 10,000/- per programme in the form of demand draft drawn in favour of Secretary, UGC and **shall reach to the Joint Secretary, Distance Education Bureau (DEB), UGC, 35 Feroze Shah Road, New Delhi-110001 within a period of 30 days from the date of the communication already issued as per clause 7, above.**

11. As stipulated under Sub-Regulation 7 of Regulations 5 of the University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020:

"No Higher Educational Institution shall offer any Open and Distance Learning Programme and/or Online Programme and admit learners thereto unless it has been granted recognition by the Commission and admission shall not be made in anticipation of the recognition".

12. In the event of any Higher Educational Institution found offering programmes in Open and Distance Learning mode and/or Online mode without recognition of the Commission or in violation to any of the provisions of these regulations and guidelines or orders made there under, the Commission may take actions as per Sub- Regulation 3 of Regulation 7 in Part -II of University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020.

Specific Provisions for Compliance

1. The Higher Educational Institution shall comply to all the terms and conditions mentioned in the Affidavit **14.10.2020** duly notarized and signed by Prof. Kanaparthi Rosaiah, Registrar submitted to the Commission vide letter dated **31.10.2020**.
2. Intake capacity under Open and Distance Learning mode for a programme under science discipline
 - For Dual Mode University: Intake shall not be more than three times of the approved intake in conventional mode.
 - For Open University: Learning enrolment will commensurate with the capacity of the Learner Support Centres to provide lab facilities to the admitted learners.
3. The Higher Educational Institution shall scrupulously abide by all the terms and conditions of faculty and staff requirements for offering ODL/ Online programmes as mentioned in University Grants Commission Open and Distance Learning Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020.
4. The total deployment of work force and other support at study or Learner Support Centres in Open and Distance Learning mode shall be as mentioned in Regulations.
5. Higher Educational Institution shall conduct proctored examination:
 - Through pen-paper or online or computer based testing within Territorial Jurisdiction, in the examination centre as per the conditions laid down in Regulations, under the direct control and responsibility of the ODL mode institution.
6. Higher Educational Institution offering programmes in Open and Distance Learning mode shall ensure that a Learner Support Centre is established within territorial jurisdiction as per the Act and Statutes of the university and as per Regulations and it also fulfill the following conditions:
 - Learner Support Centre defined under regulations, 2020 shall not be the Learner Support Centre for more than two Higher Educational Institutions at a time to offer programmes in ODL mode.
 - Learner Support Centre of a State University should be in the same state in which the State University has been established.
 - Private University established under the State Act shall be eligible to offer programmes under Open and Distance Learning mode through its Head Quarters; not through any Learner Support Centre.
 - Learner Support Centre shall not be set up under a franchisee agreement in any case.
7. Higher Educational Institution offering programme in ODL mode and Online mode shall prepare Self Learning Material as per **Annexure-VI** and **Annexure-VII** taking into consideration of the following:
 - At least 60 percent of Self Learning Materials shall be developed by the in-house faculty of the HEI and
 - Remaining percent of the materials can be sourced from available resources such as other HEIs, Open Educational Resources (OER) and SWAYAM, duly approved by the statutory authorities of the Higher Educational Institution.
8. Higher Educational Institutions shall ensure that the faculty members shown for each of the programmes in the proposal submitted by the HEI to UGC, are on 'full time dedicated basis' with designation as Professor/Associate Professor/Assistant Professor as per the requirement detailed at Annexure-IV of the University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020 and no faculty members of Learner Support Centre/other institute has been shown as faculty of the Higher Educational Institution.
9. Higher Educational Institution shall adhere to the weightage for different components of assessments for Open and Distance Learning mode as under:
 - Continuous or formative assessment (in semester): Maximum 30 per cent.
 - Summative assessment (end semester examination or term end examination): Minimum 70 per cent.
