 - 2) What are contagious diseases and communicable diseases. Write about direct and indirect transmission of HIV.
 - 3) Discuss how HIV infects White Blood Cells, lymphocytes and Eosinophils - Explain with mechanism.
 - 4) Explain the structure of virus. How it develops in the body? How do you differentiate persons who has HIV and do not have HIV virus?
 - 5) How do you classify sexually transmitted diseases (STD's)? Explain vaginal discharge and lower abdominal pain in female.
 - 6) Describe the treatment methods for STD's like genital ulcer, vaginal discharge and ophthalmia neonatorum.
 - 7) Describe the HIV transmission ways and not transmitted ways from one to one.
 - 8) Describe the steps to be taken on exposure to HIV infected persons. Write about the drugs recommended by NACO to HIV patients.
 - 9) Suggest methods for prevention and control of HIV/AIDS.
 - 10) Discuss the importance of counselling and role of teachers in the counselling for HIV/AIDS infected persons.
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
